Writing:

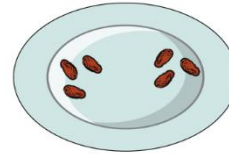
Can you practise reading and writing your red words?



Term 5

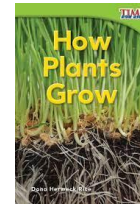
Maths:

Pick 'n Mix

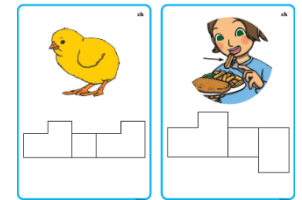
Maths:

Can you do an observational drawing of a plant? Can you label it? What materials can you use?
