

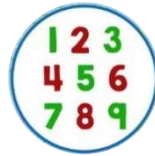

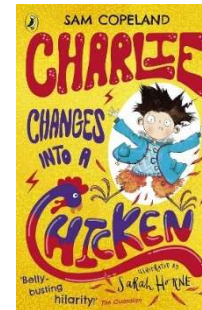
Challenge: Can you use your neatest joined handwriting to write them in sentences?
